MATT TALBOT WALKING TOUR

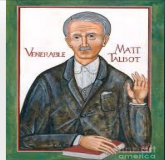
FREE WALKING TOUR, SUNDAY, MAY 12. In the footsteps of the venerable Matt Talbot.
