**Summer 2022 General Meeting of Catholic Bishops' Conference**

Members of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference gathered in-person this week for their Summer 2022 General Meeting at St Patrick's College, Maynooth. The President of the Conference is Archbishop Eamon Martin of Armagh and the Vice-President is Archbishop Dermot Farrell of Dublin. During their meeting bishops prayed for the repose of the souls of those who died from Covid-19; in consolation for their bereaved, and for everyone who continues to suffer from the virus. Bishops also remembered in their prayers victims and families of the violent atrocities perpetrated against the innocent during Mass on Pentecost Sunday in Owo, Nigeria. They also included in their prayers victims of shootings in the United States, on May 24, in Uvalde, Texas, and in Buffalo, New York, on May 14.

Food trucks, children's entertainment, picnic tables and necessary facilities will all be available in the park so that you can make a day of it with family and friends. **No tickets required.**

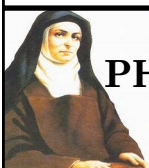


## DÚN LAOGHAIRE ORGAN CONCERTS
