There will also be refreshments, and plenty of people at hand to explain what it is all about, and how to get involved. Everyone is welcome to this special event for our city and region.

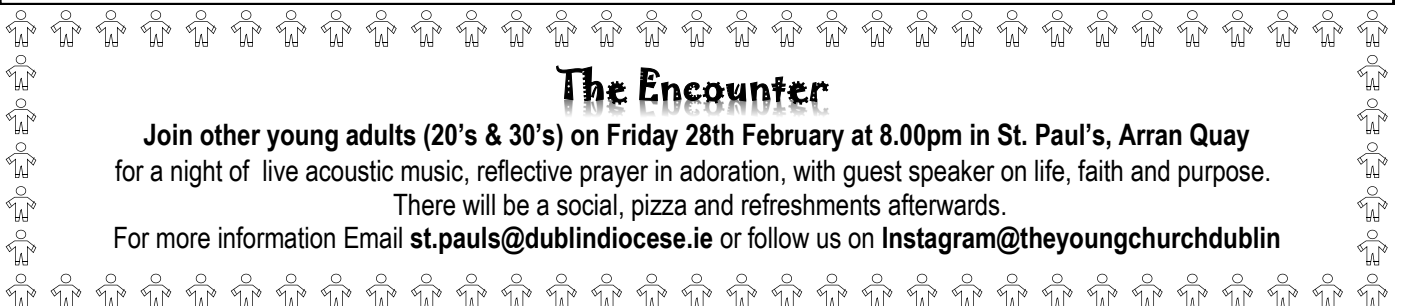
