



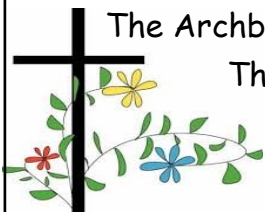

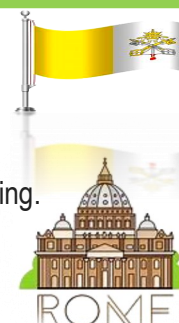
Ecumenical Pilgrimage to Rome
