Do you know of men in your parish who might like to explore the call to priesthood?

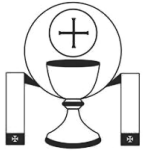

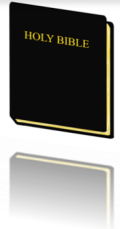
